The **purpose** of the LNHSVBBC is to promote the sport of girls' volleyball for the student-athletes of Lakeville North High School.

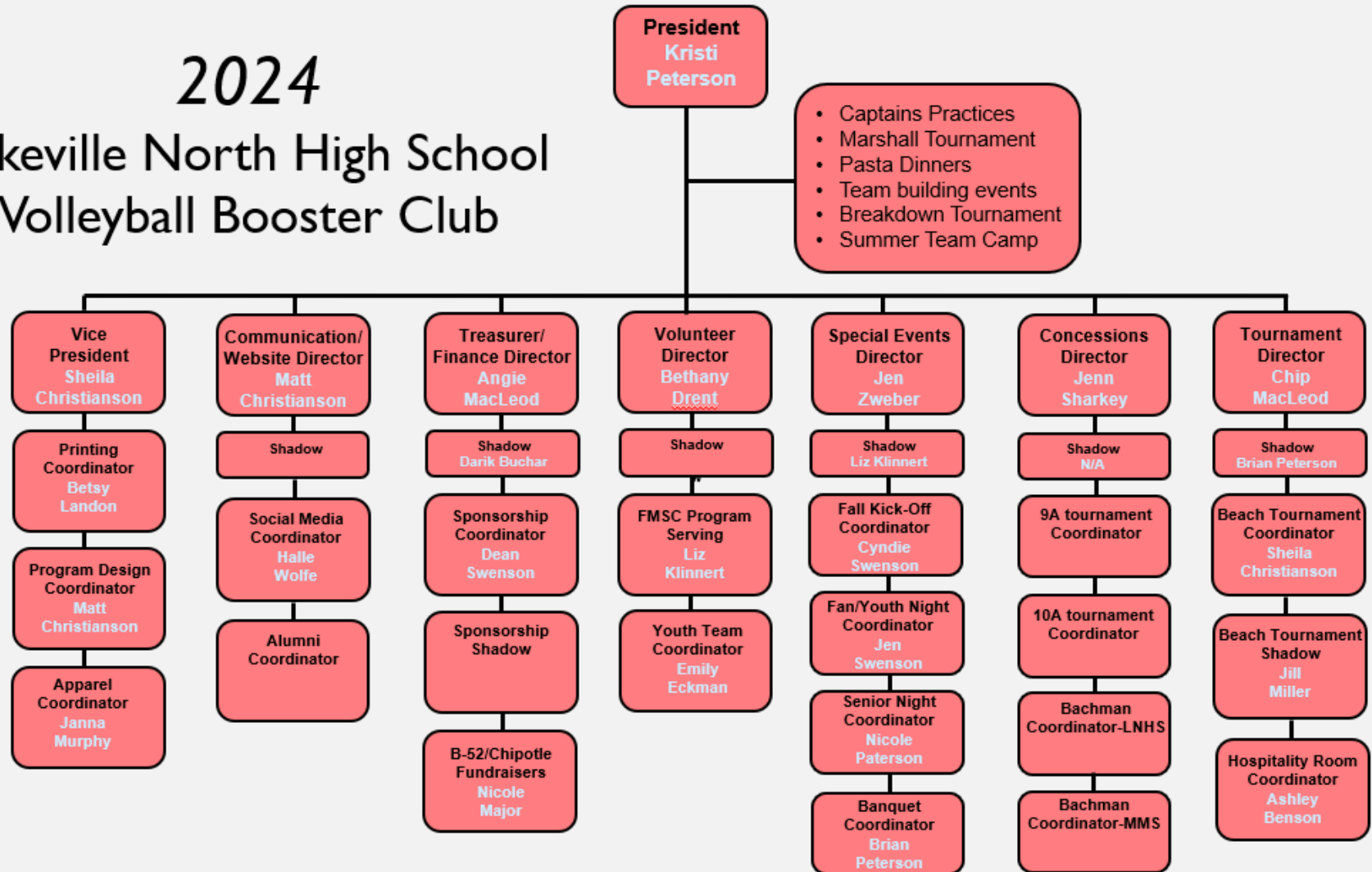

The **objective** of the LNHSVBBC is to support the long-term growth of the volleyball program and ensure that the students have the proper training, equipment and facilities in which to learn and compete.

The goals include (but are not limited to): providing financial support (financial and otherwise), to develop a sense of pride and tradition for the students, to promote and publicize the LNHS volleyball program in the community and to recognize the accomplishments of the team, the players and the coaches.

LNHSVBBC ROLES and RESPONSIBILITIES

President

Lead, guide and shape all LNHSVBBC meetings. Carry out the decisions of the general membership expressed by a majority vote of those present at vote. Carry out decisions expressed by the majority of the Executive Board. Vote only in the event there is a tie after a quorum is present. Authorized to direct the Treasurer to issued checks consistent with the budget (See Article IX). Act as the liaison between the coaching staff, school administration/Athletic Director, and the LNHSVBBC. Recommended to meet with the Head Coach & Athletic Director at the beginning of every season to discuss general business items, roles & responsibilities, new policies, etc.

Vice President

Act with the power and authority of the President in the absence of the President. Directly oversee the Apparel, Printing and Program Design Coordinators and guide/assist the responsibilities of each. The Vice President should not be a senior parent. The VP should be willing to work alongside the President and run for the President position when vacated by the current President. The Vice President is also responsible for other duties as assigned.

Communication/Website Director

Prepare and maintain full minutes of all booster meetings. This position shall conduct and keep all correspondence of the LNHSVBBC and perform other such duties that customarily pertain to communications. Keep and maintain the player/parent information including addresses, phone numbers and email addresses on a spreadsheet and update all Mail Chimp data as necessary. Keep a current list of alumni player contact information. Oversee aspects of communication from the Booster Club to the membership. All communications sent on behalf of the Booster Club to the Membership are first to be cleared through the President and Head Coach prior to sending. The Communication/Website Director is also responsible for other duties as assigned.

Special Events Director

Plan and organize all special events throughout the LNHSVB calendar year. Support, guide and direct subcommittee chairpersons dedicated specifically to the LNHSVB special events such as the Fall Kickoff, Youth/Fan Night, Senior Night, and the Banquet. The Special Events Director will assist the Captain's Parents responsibilities as needed and other duties as assigned.

Finance Director

Receive, deposit and give account of the current assets of the LNHSVBBC; have charge of all funds, securities and financial records of the LNHSVBBC; maintain appropriate records; make payments for all LNHSVBBC liabilities; submit a financial statement at each monthly Board meeting; submit a fiscal year-end statement and interface with the LNHS Booster Club as appropriate. Plan and mentor subcommittee chairpersons, organize and optimize revenue stream from events such as Tournament Ticket & Concession Sales, oversee other fundraising event(s), as well as find new sources of revenue; and other duties as assigned. The Treasurer must ensure all fundraising events are approved by the LNHSVB Head Coach, the LNHSVBBC and the LNHS Activities office.

Volunteer Director

Responsible for all aspects of recruiting and organizing volunteers for all volunteer needs of the LNHSVBBC. This includes (but not limited to): establishing volunteer needs with other LNHSVBBC Officers, creating a map of volunteer needs for each season, creating signup and reminder communications, and reporting the status and needs to the Executive Board on a frequent basis (as well as other duties as assigned).

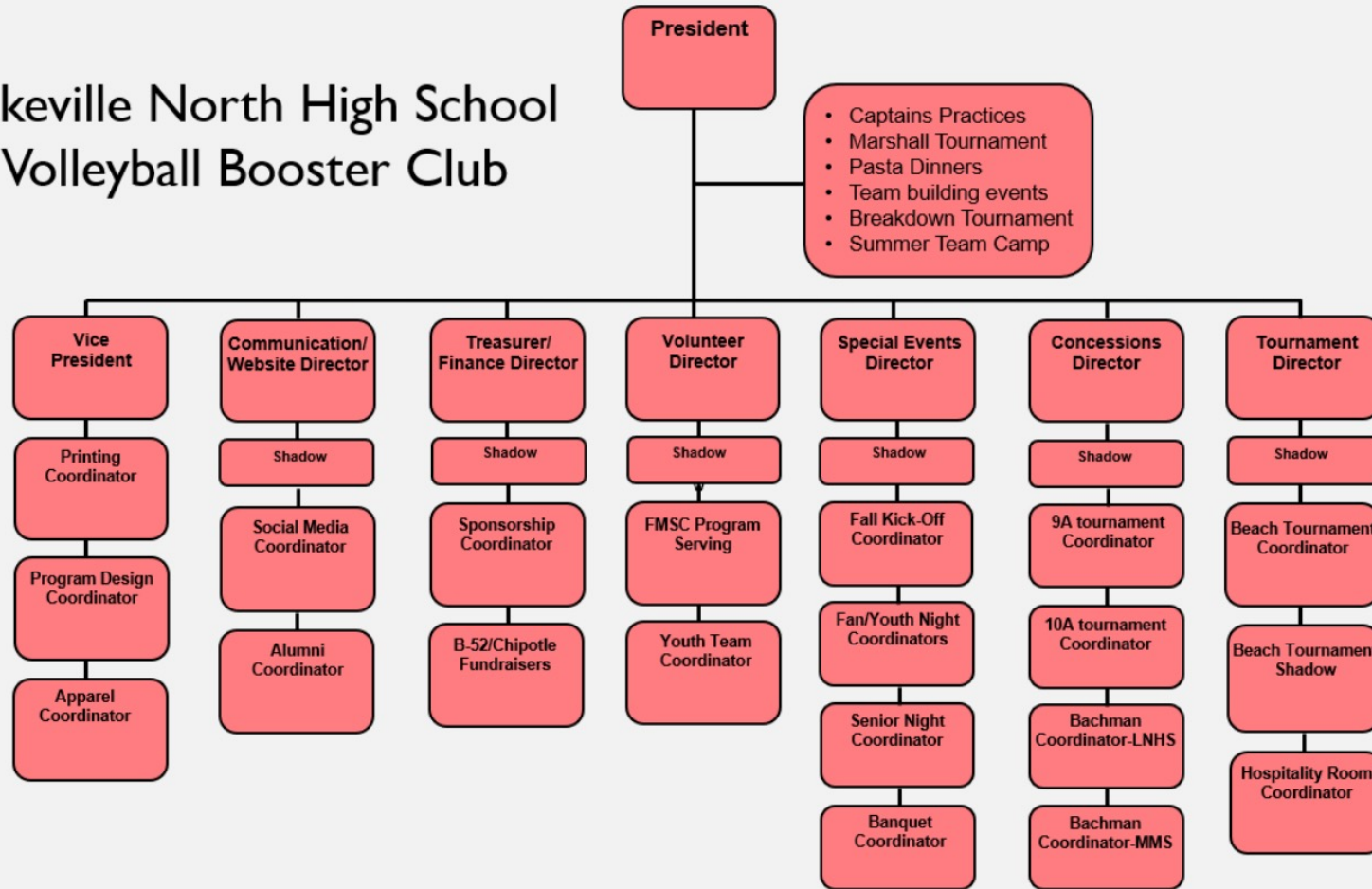
Tournament Director

Oversee and organize all aspects of tournament operations with the guidance and cooperation of the on-site LNHSVB Head Coach. Post and maintain all visible tournament brackets, programs, signage and operations during tournament events. Oversee the Hospitality Room Coordinator (Bachman Invitational only) and the Pan-O-Prog Beach Tournament (July) Coordinator; distribute direction and assistance as needed. The Tournament Director is also responsible for other duties as assigned.

Concessions Director

Oversee the complete operations of concessions at each tournament with the help of the on-site Concession Coordinators. Supervise the setup and breakdown of the concession stand; the production of all menu items; costing; shopping and delivery of the concession items. The Concession Director will pre-order all items needed the day of by local businesses (as well as other duties as assigned).

Foundation and Working Points

1. Reminder and Emphasis: *Less is More* (addition by subtraction and continue to brainstorm ways to make our operations, choices and season better).
2. Continued and yearly *investment* into the development and organization within each position (transparency in the role and the responsibilities for yearly transitions).
3. Continued transition emphasis (binders, shadow positions, etc.)
4. Directors and Coordinators within each position composing *communications* (emails and other information) to distribute to the program (per the Communications Director) for every event (with a CC to Jackie before mass distribution).
5. Financial investments to support on court/program success (Equipment, Training & Season: Hudl, Strength Room, Overnight Trip, State Tournament, Buses, Panther Prep day, Leadership Speakers, Camps, College Matches, Connection events etc.)

Purpose (of LNHSVBBC):

To promote the sport of girls' volleyball for the student-athletes of LNHS.

Objective (of LNHSVBBC):

To support the long-term growth of the volleyball program and ensure that the students have the proper training, equipment, and facilities in which to compete.

Fundraising Principles

- Less is more.
- Primary methods of raising funds to support the LNHSVB program (in priority):
 - 1) tournaments; 2) sponsorships; 3) other (if and when necessary).
- Constant assessment of what we already do. Make our strengths stronger.
- Source of revenue should be targeted outside of parents/families.
- Fundraising efforts should be primarily player-led.
- Outside of a specifically targeted fundraising need, to add an event is to add for future seasons.

Fundraising Approval Process

1. Target the need. Identify the why. Have a clear understanding of the budget.
2. With the LNHSVBBC President, complete the 'Fundraising Considerations' table.
3. With agreement to move forward, communicate the proposed fundraising event and the *Fundraising Considerations* table with a detailed description of event leadership, organization and point of contact to Head Coach.
4. Under Head Coach approval, present the fundraising event at the next scheduled booster meeting (add continued brainstorming and perspectives).
5. During the planning stages, ensure to contact season sponsors for a competitive product or service quote for consideration (when applicable). Document and compose an 'Event Binder' for operational organization and future reference for the LNHSVBBC members.

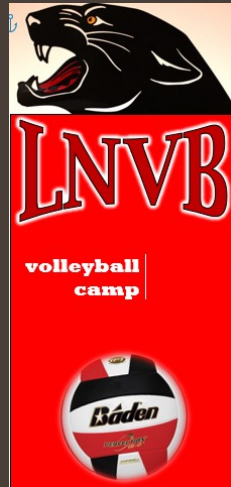
